We have modified our schedule to allow for social distancing. This may mean that there are fewer appointment times available, but we will do our best to find the most convenient time for you to come visit us. We have also purchased additional equipment and PPE to keep our patients and team members safe.

Before Your Appointment

When you arrive, please call our office at **440-461-0327** from the parking lot and wait in your vehicle. One of our team members will ask you some screening questions and get you checked in over the phone. We will then call you when we are ready for you to come in.

One parent or guardian may accompany children or patients who need special assistance. We are asking any additional friends or family members who do not have appointments to either wait in their vehicle or stay home at this time.

Following the guidance of our governor, we kindly ask that all patients wear a mask or face covering prior to entering our office to protect our staff and other patients.

Our Office

We will have hand sanitizer available near the entrance that you are encouraged to use after you come in.

We will check your temperature with a touch-free forehead thermometer to ensure that it falls within a healthy range.

You may notice that our reception area has been rearranged to help maintain social distancing. Please try to keep at least six feet of distance between yourself and anyone who you do not live with whenever possible.

If you are experiencing flu-like symptoms, have travelled within 14 days, or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19, please call us to discuss your specific situation.
